



Pet Safety Tips:

Preparing your pet emergency kit

Emergencies like storms, floods, or fires can happen at any time. You should be ready to take care of your pets for 72 hours or 3 days. A pet emergency kit will help you get through.

Preparing your kit

- The kit should be easy to find quickly, stored with your household emergency kit, and easy to carry.
- Everyone in your family should know where it is.
- Check it twice a year; replace any food that may be out of date.

What to include

- Pet food and water for 72 hours or 3 days
- A portable litter box, litter, pet waste bags, and/or pee pads
- A two-week supply of prescription medicine your pet may need
- Your veterinarian's contact information and important documents like pet vaccination records
- Extra ID tags
- Extra leash and collar
- A carrier bag or crate for the animal
- Comfort items like a favourite toy or blanket
- Small tote or bag that's easy to grab and store
